Our latest blooming sunflower, Helianthus angustifolius, blooms October up until the first frost.

Our monarch migration will be all over this as they travel south. In winter, it turns into a bird feeder as the seeds provide sustenance to songbirds.

Growing at 5-7 feet tall. Reliable late fall color for Wildlife Gardens or Meadows. Plants are also used as Butterfly Nectar Plants, Butterfly Host Plants or as part of a Grouping or Mass Planting
