## **WETLAND STATUS: Great Plains- FACU**

(Facultative Upland Plants)-Usually occur in non-wetlands (estimated probability 67% - 99%) but may occur in wetlands (estimated probability 1% - 33%)

## \*Host plant

Monarda punctata is a low growing wildflower that reaches a mature height of 1' to 3'. The whorled flowers form an elongated terminal spike. Bloom color is variable, typically cream-colored with purple spots, hence the common name spotted beebalm.
